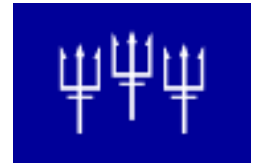

Greetings VBPS Members, Associates and Friends —

It has been quite a busy season and I would like to thank all the members who tried to keep up with our schedule. As I told the District 8 Squadron leaders, we are an extremely strong squadron and we work well together. Many of us attended the District 8 Spring Conference in Boca Raton, Fl. this year and I think we made a statement that we are "Vero Beach Proud". When I stood up to accept our awards, the best part was looking at our 2 rows of members, seeing them smile and hearing them shout and applaud. Trust me, they did not hold back their feelings and they shouldn't have. Our squadron worked very hard to achieve those honors. A list of our awards will be announced at the General Meeting and posted for you to view.

We also attended many seminars which were very informative. Many of our own members conducted those great seminars which were well attended: Lt. P/C Bill Heimbaugh,S, Lt/C Bob Scully,JN, Lt. Kathie Thomas,P, At the Friday afternoon Conference, all Squadron Commanders were asked to give a brief verbal report. I really tried to be as brief as I could. The following was my report :

" Our Squadron Educational Officer, Lt/C Alan Ebstein,SN, has certainly gotten off to a great start. The classes we have completed are: Junior Navigator, Advanced Piloting, Piloting, Seamanship, ABC3, Instructor Development, Marine Electronics System, Cruise Planning, Sail, Weather, and Partners in Command. There are four seminars scheduled for May: GPS, Radar, Paddle Smarts, and On Board Weather.

Al and his certified instructors have also been working with the Youth Sailing Foundation of Indian River County. We provide instructors in the classroom and on the water. We have sponsored and constructed Optimist Sailing Dinghys for those less fortunate. I had the opportunity to construct one of these Dinghys and Harold and I donated it. It was quite a learning experience.

Between January and April 30th, we have recruited 35 new members, 5 reinstatements, and 4 transfers. That brings us up to 373 members. This is mainly due to our Membership Chairman, Lt. Kathie Thomas,P, her committee and of course, our own members. They have done an exceptional job of not only recruiting but retaining. We do hold a New Members Party at our home for the members who have joined in the past year. Usually it is about 35. This time it was 90.

We have a very active squadron. Some of our activities include: A Poker Run, mini cruises, raft-ups, a dinner every month, a ladies pot luck luncheon, a book club, golfing, and we just returned from a 2 week cruise in our boats to Banana Bay, Marathon. We also take the Boys and Girls Club of Indian River County fishing and treat them to lunch, in addition, we are involved with the Vero Beach Hibiscus Children's Center, we have a booth at the Vero Beach Boat Show, collect Treats for the Troops and are now getting involved with the Sea Scouts.

Of course, we have submitted our posters for the P/C Robert "Woody" Boarman, AP National Youth Poster Contest. This year we entertained our winners with a luncheon, presented them with their awards and took them for a boat ride.

We also made hot dogs and hamburgers at the Environmental Learning Center Festival and donated the proceeds back to them. We have been involved with the ELC for a number of years. Our co op charting members act as lifeguards for the children who learn about boating for a three week period. Speaking of our co op charting group, they have also been busy with a total of 18 submissions. We have also completed 52 vessel safety checks.

We have a speaker for every General Meeting and of course, there is our famous and popular Friday Night Socials.

Our communications center is very strong with P/C Robert "Woody" Boarman,AP, serving as our Webmaster and also Editor of our newsletter, The Nautical News. Please return to the D/8 Fall Conference for the rest of the Story".
